Gloucester Diocese is proud to own what is considered to be one of the premier Diocesan retreat houses in the country.

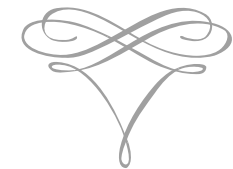
